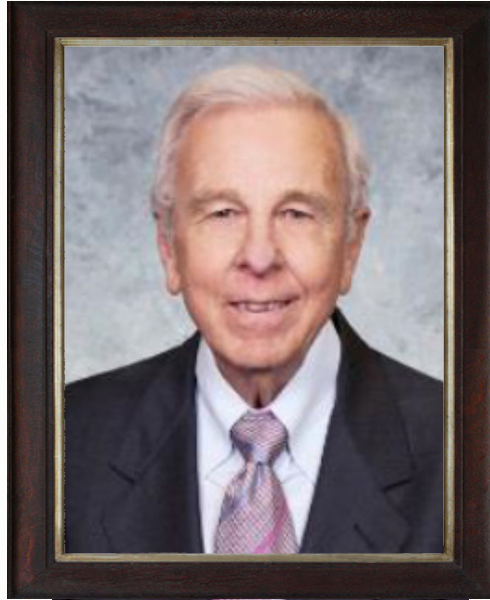


GILBERT I. “BUDDY” LOW
